Application process:

1. Submit your application at myshanghai.org under "How to Apply"
2. Receive an email containing your acceptance status within 1-2 weeks
3. Receive additional trip information and begin populating required forms
4. Initiate the visa process and book plane tickets with our assistance, and receive your detailed trip itinerary
5. Leave for Shanghai in June!

Spots are first come first serve, so make sure to submit an application as soon as possible. We hope to see you this summer!
